NESFIELD stalked the early leader from the outside, moved clear approaching the lane, remained clear into deep stretch but had to settle for the dead heat for the win. RANSOM DUE was unhurried while out from the rail, rallied outside through the lane and was up in time for the dead heat. READ RICHIES NOTES had early position in the three path, fell back on the final turn and continued evenly late. BANKER BAILOUT stayed out from the rail with the early lead and weakened. MARK UP TINY reared in the gate at the break then raced wide around the first turn and made up ground outside through the lane. GIRLS' GETAWAY was in tight along the rail around the first turn, remained prominent into the far turn then weakened. SILVER PARTNER was outrun. AMERICAN BREW stopped.
