SPEEDSKI showed speed, stayed out from the rail once clear on the turn and held under brisk urging. SMARTY BULL was kept close while racing well out from the rail and gained mildly. LIL PRECIOUS was slow early, rallied well out from the rail around the turn, was caught behind rivals entering the stretch, angled in for room and gained to the end. PRINCESS TAPIT stayed out from the rail and couldn't gain. FANCY NOTION came out wide on the turn and weakened. SMILING VICKI broke slowly then was outrun inside. WHITE STILETTO was outrun two wide. BID REPORT angled to the inside with the early lead then stopped and was eased up late.
