SOUTHERN FLAIR vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the turn, then drew off in the stretch and finished under urging. TWITCHY pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then was no match for the winner in the final yards, an objection was lodged by the rider of HAVRE DE PLACE for interference leaving the starting gate, after review the stewards saw no cause for any disqualification. GRAEME'S SONG was slow early, raced along the two path on the turn, then closed ground late. A WONDERFUL WORLD pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the turn, then weakened in the drive. GREAT GRANCAT stalked the pace early, raced along the four path on the turn, then faded in the drive. HAVRE DE PLACE was void of early speed, raced along the four path on the turn and failed to menace. TASTEFULLY SIMPLE showed brief speed, raced along the three path on the turn and was not a factor. DEL MAR HENNY vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faltered late. KENDRA'S QUEEN showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn, then lacked a rally and broke down after the race and did not recover. YOURFIRSTAFTERME was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then faded in the drive. WILL'S LIL lacked speed, saved ground through the turn while trailing the field.
