TIP OF THE SWORD was slow early, stayed inside to the stretch, angled out while rallying and was along in time. BAKHOOR pressed the early leader two wide, took over in early stretch, held on late then faltered. HALTON GULLY had position three wide but lacked the needed closing. HAVING SAID THAT was bumped soundly at the break, moved up inside and lacked a strong closing. KASH KOW KAZ stayed out from the inside and lacked a rally. PLEASURE BOAT was slow to settle then gained late outside. JUSTA AVERAGE JOE was lagged to the stretch then made up ground through traffic. PERFECT GENTLEMAN was slow from the gate, stayed close to the inside around the turn then made up ground too late. CAPTAIN SPITLER was unhurried early, came out between horse in early stretch and was caught in tight late. R LITTLE LUCKY wasn't far back outside early then tired. ANZIO ADAM was outrun three wide. BOREAL FOREST ducked in leaving the gate, was hustled to command after going a furlong then stopped in the lane.
