HURRICANE BAY stalked the pace from the start, raced along the two path through the last turn, then gained a late lead and just lasted. SOUTHERN JERZEE was unhurried early, raced along the four path on the far turn, then closed ground late and hung. MACHO GRIS pressed the pace from the start, raced four wide on the far turn, then weakened late, an objection was lodged by the rider of EMPEROR'S ROBE for interference on the far turn, after review the stewards took no action. EMPEROR'S ROBE prompted the pace from the start, raced three wide on the last turn then tired in the drive. MY DIVIDEND was slow early, raced along the three path on the far turn, then lacked a rally. FUSEDUP was close up early, saved ground on the second turn and failed to menace. RULING POWER vied for the lead from the two path through the far turn, was engaged in a long drive then faltered late. ROCK FOR AGES vied for the lead from along the inside through the second turn, then flattened out in the drive.
