PEACETIME MISSY vied for the lead from the two path, then drew off on the second turn and finished under urging. SPEEDY SWEETY was unhurried early, raced two wide on the last turn, then made a late bid to be second best. DONAMIA was void of early speed, raced four wide on the far turn, then closed ground willingly. REAL AMERICAN GIRL pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide through the second turn, then weakened late. TIZ A LILY was close up and three wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. BRITANNIA saved ground but showed little. DEVILENA vied for the lead from the inside, then faltered on the last turn. SHAMEEKA was through early, raced three wide on the far turn and was outrun.
