### Footnotes

GIOP (IRE) was unhurried early, hit the rail early on the backstretch, rallied the rail into tight quarters entering the far turn, came out before a mile and ran clear late. PRETTY MR. D set or forced the pace two wide into the far turn, regained ground to open a short lead before going a mile but couldn't contain the winner. NO INFLATION raced three wide with the early leaders, loomed a threat between the top two into the final sixteenth then weakened. DAVID K was slow early, made a run outside horses on the backstretch, raced two wide around the final turn and lacked a strong closing. GREAT HARBOUR set or forced the pace along the rail to the stretch, came out from the rail and weakened. NIGHTSCAPE stayed inside and lacked a rally. SUPER DOC was no factor. KING'S CORONATION weakened. GHOSTS AND LEGENDS was no factor. KENTUCKY RIDDLER pulled up after going a half and was walked off the course.
