MS DESSERT WARRIOR stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, then drew off in the stretch while under urging. PRINCIPESA HEATHER pressed the pace early, raced two wide through the turn, then was no match for the winner in the stretch. CALLY DRIVE was unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn, then made a late bid for show. JO JO JUICE was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn then rallied mildly in the lane. SARAVASRHYTHM was close up early, raced two wide on the turn then weakened. ESTUPENDA pressed the pace from the inside on the turn then faded. SANTORINI SUNSET was slow early, raced two wide on the turn and was not a threat. RAJA DAJA was slow early, raced inside on the turn, then passed the tired ones. LUCKENBACH MOON was close up early, raced three wide on the turn then faded. FOREVER AN ANGEL raced two wide on the turn and was through after a half. MEGAWATT raced four wide on the turn and failed to menace. COLUMBINA set the pace from along the inside through the turn, then flattened out in the drive.
