GENTLEMEN'S NICK was close up and three wide, reached contention on the second turn then drew off under urging. LEXI'S KNOCKOUT was unhurried early, raced three wide on the last turn, then rallied late to be second best. QUARTERBACK SNEAK was slow early, raced four wide on the far turn and made a good closing effort. RAELYN'S FRIEND pressed the pace from along the inside through the far turn, then weakened in the lane. GAMBINE ROAD stalked the pace from the two path, reached contention on the second turn then faded in the drive. LIDO KEY was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn then faltered. BEAVER CREEK set the pace with a clear lead, raced along the inside and was headed on the last turn then gave way. BALTIMORE NATIVE saved ground but trailed throughout.
