I AM THE KING stalked the pace from the two path through the far turn, then drew off and finished under urging. SURE START pressed the pace from along the inside through the last turn, then made a late bid and finished second best. WILD AND WILEY was unhurried early, saved ground on the second turn then made a mild rally in the stretch. BLACK CHEVRON set the pace from the start, saved ground through the second turn, then gave way in the stretch. WARSHAW was close up early, raced along the three path on the far turn, then faded in the lane.
