LIGHTLY WOUND vied for the early lead from along the two path, then drew off on the backstretch and saved ground thereafter while finishing under left handed encouragement. MADDISONS PASSION vied for the lead from along the inside, then dropped back and raced two wide through the last turn before making a late bid. GREAT INVESTMENT stumbled at the start then trailed the field early, saved ground on the far turn and closed ground willingly. SPINNING OUT was close up and along the two path through the second turn, then weakened late. DOMESTIC CIRCLE was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn, then flattened out late. EXTRA HONOR was through early, saved ground on the last turn and was outrun.
