Footnotes

ICTALURUS was unhurried early, raced along the inside through the last turn then angled to the outside approaching the head of the stretch and drew off while under steady encouragement. OBSERVER was slow early, raced four wide on the second turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. CLUCK FOR BUCKS broke sharply to set the pace with a clear lead, saved ground throughout then tired late. CAN DO KID was void of early speed, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. PHOEBUS RISING was slow early, raced along the three path on the far turn, then failed to menace. AVILORD was close up early, raced four wide into the second turn, but lacked a late rally. DON'T DOUBT ME pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the last turn and faltered. OUR MEDALIST stalked the pace from the two path, contended early then dropped back and was outrun. PLEASANT HENNY prompted the early pace, was through after a half, then pulled up at the top of the stretch.
