HONEST PAUL was slow early, saved ground through the turn then angled outward and drew off to win easily. FIRST TRUMPET vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, gained command in the stretch then was outfinished. NICETOSEEEY'AGAIN was void of early speed, raced four wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. OOPERS HERE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the turn then faltered in the stretch. DEANO GUSKA was close up early, raced three wide on the turn then faded in the stretch. CITY TRAIN saved ground but failed to menace. COCO POINT was close up and inside on the turn, then was through after a half and outrun.
