MUSIC CLUB BELLE stalked the pace from the two path, then gained command on the turn and finished under steady encouragement. ELISSA GREELEY was close up and two wide through the turn, while racing evenly to be second best. SPEEDWAY MONKEY was unhurried early, raced two wide through the turn, then made a late bid. DANCING SPARKS was void of early speed, saved ground through the turn and made a mild bid in the stretch. ZAMITA was outrun to mid stretch, saved ground on the turn, then passed tiring rivals. AMY'SGOTAROCKET set the pace early, raced along the inside through the turn, then faded in the stretch. REALLY BULLISH was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn then faltered and was outrun.
