LYLE'S ANGEL vied for the lead from the start, raced along the two path through the second turn and drew off while under urging. LIVING ALOHA was close up early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. GYPSY TRAVELER was unhurried early, raced two wide on the far turn then angled outward but lacked a rally. JACKPOT LADY vied for the lead from along the inside to the far turn, then faltered in the stretch. ROMOLO'S JULIET was slow early, raced along the two path on the second turn and was not a threat. PATTONS MAGIC lacked speed, raced along the two path through the far turn, then passed one late. BALLET CORPS was void of early speed, raced along the inside on the second turn then flattened out.
