TIZNOW TRUE was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then reached contention late and drew off under urging. CATS N ROSES was unhurried early, raced four wide on the turn, then made a late bid and was second best. URAGREATAMERICAN was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then found his best stride late. SMARTLY CLOUDY raced along the inside on the turn and lacked a rally. RAPID RAMPAGE pressed the pace from along the inside through the turn, then faded in the stretch. SALORI KAZ vied for the early lead, raced along the inside then drew clear on the turn but gave way in mid stretch. COBALT CHROME vied for the early lead, raced two wide through the turn, then faltered in the stretch. FUSEDUP lacked speed, saved ground and was outrun.
