PICK MAGNET settled early, came out three wide nearing the stretch while rallying and prevailed. SARAS MOST WANTED was never far back while racing two wide, vied inside the winner through the lane but wasn't enough. LAD'S TRICK showed speed two wide, moved clear before a half then tired in the lane. SPINNING OUT was slow early then outfinished tired ones. BATTLE MOUNTAIN bore out on the final turn and stopped. BRANDAL was outrun inside. STRATEGIC VISSION stopped. HENRY THE MINISTER made the early pace inside then stopped and was eased up. BIG STRIKER showed little and was eased before six furlongs.
