**Footnotes**

PINK CANDY moved through the inside to gain command just after a quarter, drew out on the turn, lugged in under right hand whip and bumped MELPOMENE in early stretch then was kept to right hand while and held. Following an objection and inquiry, PINK CANDY was disqualified and placed second. MELPOMENE settle, ran out a bit while moving to vie inside the leader into the stretch, was bumped in early stretch then drifted late and missed. SOLID ARGUMENT was never far back, raced three wide into the stretch, gave her best into the final furlong but failed to sustain. MAPLES WAY wasn't far back early, raced wide around the turn and weakened. SMART RULER lagged early, angled to the inside on the turn and lacked a strong closing. MOUNTIAN GAL came out after the break, stayed out from the rail while making the early pace then stopped.
