Footnotes

PHOTO OPPORTUNITY stalked the early leader from the outside, moved to the front entering the stretch and drove clear. WILD DEPOSIT wasn't far back between horses, angled to the rail on the turn, moved closer before five furlongs then hung. SCULLION lagged early, rallied wide around the turn and finished fast. SMARTYS BUDDY was unhurried early, stayed inside and made up some ground. BE A PAL stayed out from the inside while making the way to the stretch then tired. DUSTY REEF was slow early, stayed inside around the turn and made up ground late. BEN THE BEAST raced wide into the stretch and made up ground too late. THIS BULLS BACK showed speed inside then tired. EXPECT A GRAMMY was no factor. TARAS BULBA was wide and tired. CAPTAIN'S BOY stopped and was eased up.
