**Footnotes**

PEGASUS TOMMY D. stalked the pace from the two path and reached contention on the last turn, then engaged in a long drive and prevailed while under urging. COOL C NOTE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside throughout, then dueled to the wire and just missed. COURAGE TO BE was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the top two. SACO RIVER was unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, then found his best stride late. THUNDER BREW was slow early, raced four wide on the last turn, then made a mild bid late before weakening. TIME FOR TUTT was void of early speed, saved ground on the second turn and rallied mildly. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE lacked speed, raced four wide on the far turn, then passed the tired ones. WOLVERTON pressed the pace from the start, raced four wide on the last turn, then faded late. GRETSKY was close up early, raced inside on the second turn, then faltered late. ADIRONDACK FOREST vied for the lead from the start, raced three wide into the second turn then flattened out.
