DEMAND A FAVOR stalked the pace from along the inside through the second turn, drew off late then held well while under urging. MORNING'S IMAGE was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the last turn, angled outward in the stretch and rallied, just missing at the wire. NIGHTSCAPE was slow early, raced three wide on the far turn, checked at the top of the stretch, then angled outward and finished well. JUDICIAL was void of early speed, saved ground on the second turn, then closed willingly. BOWLER set the pace from the start, raced two wide through the far turn, then weakened late. RHYME OR REASON pressed the pace early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then tired from those efforts. I AM THE FUTURE was close up, raced four wide at the 1/4 pole, then faded thereafter. STORM RISING was three wide through the far turn and failed to menace. CLASSY LAUREN prompted the early pace, raced along the two path on the last turn, then flattened out in the stretch. EIGHT MILE ROCK was through after a half. PRIME TIME TICKET was close up early, then faltered nearing the stretch and was outrun.
