Footnotes

ONE HOT HAND was unhurried, began a run three between rivals nearing the end of the backstretch, rallied three wide around the final turn, drew clear in early stretch then bore out under left hand whip and held. KISSNATALIE was unhurried inside, came out while moving on the final turn, angled out while moving closer before a mile then hung. EASTER CHILD was unhurried inside, began a run on the final turn, came out in the lane and finished willingly. SATIN settled early, rallied outside the winner around the final turn then flattened out in the lane. ADANNA lagged early, made a wide run around the final turn and made up some ground through the lane. TEE DOTTIE showed speed two wide for over a half then tired. MY ANGEL BECCA stayed inside and made up some ground too late. EVEN PRETTIER steadied between rivals into the far turn while no factor. BUNNY BLIZZARD wasn't far back early, moved to vie two wide into the far turn then tired in the lane. NUMBER FORTY ONE made the pace along the rail to the end of the backstretch then stopped. FIELD QUEEN was no factor. WATCH DORA was outrun.
