Footnotes

THE GREAT BANDINI made the pace along the rail, came again past midstretch and prevailed. OUR MISTER was unhurried early, stayed well out into the track around the turn and came in some late while closing well. PART ONE wasn't far back while racing well out from the rail around the turn, was brushed in midstretch then closed well while in tight between horses. SMALL GIANT pressed the winner early, opened a short lead before a half then gave way. COLE'S GOT SOUL was well in hand while behind the early leaders, edged well out from the rail for room approaching the lane, and lacked a strong closing while in tight through the final yards. H O'S BIRTHDAY was bumped at the break, angled to the rail on the turn and gained mildly through the lane. SHARP DEFREERE was unhurried, raced two wide around the turn and steadied in tight between horses through the final yards. SUNSHINEINTHERAIN ducked out leaving the gate then trailed.
