TRUE LAD was unhurried inside, moved to vie in early stretch then drove clear after a mile. LITTLE NICHOLAS was never far back outside, moved clear from the outside before going three quarters then faltered. COLE HAMELS raced two wide around the final turn and weakened. CHEMICAL AL cleared into the first turn, angled to the rail then had nothing left for the drive. THE KAHN MAN was outrun. BRUT AND THELILBEE lost contact with the field after a half.
