FIRST NITE pressed the early leader two wide, moved clear midway on the final turn, was headed in early stretch then came again. LYCIAN was unhurried inside, came out two wide while moving on the final turn, opened a short lead into the final furlong but wasn't enough. COTTON HEARTED was unhurried then rallied outside late. HEFFERMAN was slow to find best stride. SHINE FOR STEVE came out three wide on the final turn while moving then flattened out. DAVID K was outrun inside. GORDONRYAN made the early pace inside then stopped and was eased through the lane. HIPPOCRATES JONES lost contact early and was distanced.
