### Footnotes

MOON ECHO vied for the lead from the start, raced along the two path on the turn and dueled in the stretch, then drew clear while under steady urging. MUTTFACE DIANE vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then gave way after a long drive. JANUARY ANGEL was void of early speed, raced along the two path through the turn, then angled outward in the stretch and made a late bid. MONZY pressed the pace from the three path on the turn, then failed to sustain a bid. RING MAIDEN was close up early, raced inside on the turn, then lacked a late response. POHATAN PRINCESS lacked speed, saved ground on the turn, then showed little. CUKROS was close up early and three wide on the turn, then drifted out in the stretch and was outrun.
