DRAYTON HALL was unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn then angled outward and drew off late while under urging. ECHSTEIN VILLAGE set the pace from the start, raced two wide on the last turn while holding a clear lead, then gave way in the stretch. BRUSH ON BY was void of early speed, raced four wide on the far turn, then found his best stride late. MISSION GAP was close up and two wide through the second turn, then weakened late. JAKE'S MISSION raced three wide on the second turn and failed to menace. TURN TO THE KING pressed the early pace, raced along the inside on the far turn, then faded in the stretch. PRETTY MR. D prompted the pace from the two path through the second turn then faltered late. WHATEVERITTAKES stalked the pace early, raced three wide on the second turn, then flattened out late.
