LAS MERCEDES was slow early, raced three wide on the second turn, then rallied and drew off late while under urging. NEPHILA was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then gained command but was outfinished late. ALMOST GRECIAN was void of early speed, raced along the inside on the last turn, then closed ground willingly. STAINED GLASS was unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, then lacked a late response. MARK UP TINY vied for the lead from the two path into the second turn, then faltered in the stretch. ECLIPTICALS WHISKY vied for the lead from along the inside, then flattened out on the far turn. LIVING LAVIDIA LETA stalked the pace early, raced three wide on the second turn, then tired late and was outrun.
