ITSNOTTHERIGHT vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then drew clear late while under urging. AVARICE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside throughout, entered into a long drive then gave way late. WITTY KID was close up and two wide on the turn, then rallied late and finished well. VALID CITIZEN was never far back, raced two wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly. GRAND MACHO pressed the pace early, saved ground on the turn, then lacked a late response. CORTADO was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. TIP OF THE SWORD was slow early, raced four wide on the turn and not a factor. HALTON GULLY was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn, then faded in the stretch. BELIEVE ITS TRUE vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the turn and was through after a half.
