MASTER DREAMER was unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn and reached contention, then drew clear in the stretch and finished under urging. BELLAMY XPRESS pressed the pace early, saved ground on the last turn then angled outward and rallied mildly to finish second best. KINGS VILLAGE was slow early, raced three wide on the second turn and advanced steadily to finish well. ROCKSTAR LIFE was void of early speed, raced two wide on the far turn, then rallied mildly late. LINCHESTER raced four wide on the second turn and lacked a rally. FARLEY HILL was close up early, raced two wide through the far turn, then faltered in the stretch. RAISE THE CODE lacked speed, raced two wide on the second turn, then passed tiring rivals. KING IBIS was through early, raced inside on the far turn and showed little. CRASH MAGEE set the pace with a clear lead from the start, raced along the inside on the second turn then flattened out.
