SATELLITE BEACH stalked the pace early, raced two wide on the far turn, then reached contention in mid stretch and prevailed at the wire. ASK OMMADON was slow early, raced three wide on the last turn, then closed ground fast and just missed. WYNN WILLIE WYNN vied for the lead from along the inside, gained command on the second turn, then gave way late. IRISH MAJESTY was unhurried early, raced along the three path through the far turn, then made a mild bid late. MEDAGLIA'S IMAGE was slow early, raced three wide on the last turn, then made a late bid and tired. PICO PICO was void of early speed, saved ground on the second turn then rallied mildly in the stretch. GOOD GENERAL was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then faded in the stretch. ALINA'S LAD vied for the early lead, raced along the inside on the last turn then faltered. QUAIL HOLLOW raced along the two path on the far turn, faded to menace and was outrun.
