HONEST PAUL was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then gained command late and finished under urging. LEGACY WILDCAT stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then gave way in the stretch. DIXIE BAND was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the turn, then closed ground late. R J'S PROSPECT was void of early speed, raced four wide on the turn, then closed willingly. ROMANS REWARD was close up early, raced two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. OUR HAE pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. MOVIN' OUT vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then tired in mid stretch. CERTIFIABLY ROYAL was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn then faded late. NICETOSEY'AGAIN raced along the four path on the turn and failed to menace. SLOW NICK C lacked speed, raced inside on the turn and showed little throughout. CITY TRAIN raced three wide on the turn and was never a threat. COCO POINT pressed the pace but was through early and outrun.
