CHILE REINA broke alertly, then set all the pace with a clear lead and finished under steady urging. SWEET LIL DANCER was close up on the backstretch, raced three wide on the turn and finished in an even effort. BAMBI BABY stalked the pace from the two path through the turn, then failed to sustain her bid. CANELA DULCE broke slowly, raced four wide on the turn and made a mild bid. CORDON NEGRO was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. OURGRANDLINDSEY was slow early, raced three wide on the turn and was not a factor. RUN FOR GLORY (VEN) pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the turn and faded at the 1/4 pole. SUDDENLY COOL showed good early speed, raced inside on the turn but lacked a late response. LUNAR SONATA was in the middle of the pace early, lacked a rally and was outrun.
