PLYMOUTH SQUARE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the last turn, then dueled in the stretch and prevailed, a stewards' inquiry and an objection was lodged by the rider of HANDY ANDY for interference in the run through the stretch, after review the stewards saw no cause for an disqualification. HANDY ANDY vied for the lead from the two path through out, was engaged in a long drive and just missed. ROYAL IGNITION was unhurried early, raced two wide on the last turn then angled outward and rallied mildly in the lane. DUTTONS PRIDE was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn and faded. QUIET TITLE was void of early speed, raced four wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. SIXSIXTEEN was close up early, raced three wide on the last turn and faltered thereafter. ALEX'S MOJO was slow early, raced inside on the second turn and was never a factor. BROKEN LEGACY pressed the pace while saving ground through the last turn, then faltered and was outrun.
