REGENCY ROAD vied for the early lead, saved ground on the turn, then drew clear at the 1/4 pole and finished under steady urging. MINER'S GLOW was slow early, raced inside on the turn, then rallied from along the rail and finished well. HALOS WONDER vied for the early lead, raced three wide on the turn, then drifted badly in the stretch and lost ground. PVT. BLUE BIRD was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace. SANDY'S PEAK was two wide on the turn and never a threat. TOLDRA raced four wide on the turn and was outrun.
