PRINCESS PUMP IRON stalked the pace early, raced three wide on the turn then rallied late and prevailed at the wire. CUKROS set the pace with a clear lead, was headed in mid stretch, then was outfinished at the wire. FLAME TETRA pressed the pace from along the inside into the turn, then finished evenly. FOREAL prompted the pace from the two path, then failed to sustain a bid. LYNDAA DEE saved ground. RHYTHM DOWN BELOW saved ground and found her best stride late. SAFE TRY was three wide on the turn and was outrun.
