CHAIRMAN TUCKER vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then drew off late while under urging. TEMPESTA DI NEVE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the turn to mid stretch then gave way. SIR GALAHAD was slow early, raced along the inside on the turn, then found his best stride late. BUTCHER HERB was never far back, raced along the inside on the turn, then lacked a late response. ADAM'S NAY was void of early speed, raced two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. PHOR PHILIPPE stalked the early pace, raced three wide on the turn then weakened. LING LING QI raced two wide through the turn and failed to menace. PERFECT FOOTPRINT pressed the early pace, raced three wide on the turn, then faded in the stretch. SMOOTH TALKIN' MAN was through early, raced three wide on the turn and was outrun.
