RED PETE showed speed inside, was displaced just before a half, edged clear in deep stretch and held. SMALL GIANT was never far back inside, came out in early stretch then closed a gap in the final yards. MCCARTY moved three wide to vie nearing the stretch, opened a short lead before a half then faltered. DIRT TRACK DEMON was slow early, raced two wide around the turn and gained through the lane. KASH KOW KAZ stayed inside in an even effort. VIGORS STORM became a bit fractious then had his head turned to the inside by the assistant starter just before the break and was very slow from the gate, moved up outside early, raced three wide around the turn and tired. TIDEWATER showed speed two wide into the turn then tired. BATTLEGROUND was finished early.
