HOT RODDER settled in good position, moved two wide to command early on the far turn and was under steady urging through the lane. LUSTERDUST was unhurried after a slow break, raced three wide around the final turn and gained slowly through the lane. KHABIBULIN took over entering the first turn, stayed inside while making the way to the far turn then weakened. LISTENTOTHEJUNKMAN bobbled a few strides out of the gate then failed to menace. CANAL STREET was outrun. BIG NUGGET stopped. STARS AND BOOTS showed speed three wide then stopped and was eased up late. PREACHER'S KID showed speed two wide for over a half then stopped.
