EXTREME WAYS set the pace while saving ground, held a clear lead throughout and finished under urging. MS MIA pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, then was no match for the winner. MISS PAULINE was close up early, raced three wide on the turn, then lacked a rally. NASDAQ QUEEN stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then weakened in the stretch. CHISELING NICKIE was void of early speed, raced four wide on the turn, then passed the tired ones. WILD NIGHT saved ground but was not a threat. DIAMOND LAUR raced along the inside on the turn and failed to menace. SHALL WE GATHER lacked speed and showed little. MISTY SUNRISE was through early and outrun.
