TIP OF THE SWORD was unhurried after a slow break, rallied the rail into the stretch, vied into the final sixteenth and prevailed. COULDBEAGHOSTRIDER was unhurried, was brushed while rallying four wide into the stretch, drew out before five furlongs then gave way. POPULAR CAUSE wasn't far back while racing out from the rail but lacked a closing response. STAKIN STEWART had early position, vied two wide into the stretch then tired. RODERICK ran out into COULDBEAGHOSTRIDER while racing three wide between horses into the stretch then flattened out. COPPER AND CHROME cleared early, stayed inside and tired. SWEETCANDYMAN was outrun. CAPTAIN CAGEY stopped.
