FOREIGN REVIEW was rated outside the early leader while racing the three path, took over early on the far turn, was clear in early stretch and widened under brisk urging. RIMRAM lagged early, rallied well out from the rail around the final turn and finished with good energy outside. JUST HOLLER wasn't far back when caught in tight between horses on the backstretch, raced two wide around the final turn then weakened in the lane. CAN DO KID was slow to settle, raced two wide around the final turn and lacked a strong closing. CLUCK FOR BUCKS stayed out from the rail once clear soon after the break then tired in the lane. URAGREATAMERICAN moved up inside on the backstretch to press the early leader then tired. OBSERVER advanced into tight quarters between horses on the backstretch then stopped. DYNAMITE CAT wasn't far back between horses early then stopped and was eased through the lane.
