CHAC MOOL vied for the early lead from the two path, then drew clear on the turn and finished under urging. FIT was close up and three wide on the turn then finished second best. MYERSROCKS was slow early, raced two wide on the turn then made a mild bid in the stretch. TIMBER WEST was close up and four wide on the turn while racing evenly. VAN LEROY was never far back, raced along the inside through the turn then made a late bid. BOHEMIAN DREAM was void of early speed, raced three wide on the turn and lacked a rally. UNCLE ELI lacked speed, raced along the inside on the turn and showed little. NICETOSEY'AGAIN raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. MORE DRAMA vied for the lead early, raced along the inside on the turn then faded late. GEONI showed brief speed, raced two wide on the turn, then faltered late. JO DANCER trailed from the start and was outdistanced.
