INDIANSKI vied for the early lead from the two path, then drew off on the turn and just lasted at the wire while under urging. DEBIT CARD stalked the pace from the start, raced along the two path on the turn, then rallied late and just missed. DELAWARE RIVER was close up and inside early, then checked briefly at the 3/8 pole and finished evenly. RICKYONTHERUN was never far back, raced three wide on the turn then rallied mildly in the lane. B'CAUSE B'CAUSE vied for the early lead from the inside, then check at the 3/8 pole, lacked a late rally then lodged a claim of foul against the winner but the claim was denied. SPRIDAL was never far back, raced inside on the turn, then lacked a rally. STRAIGHT THUNDER lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. FUNKY PIRATE saved ground but trailed throughout.
