NOBEL LEX stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, then rallied late to reach contention then drew off under urging. YARDEE was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then made a late bid and finished second best. FOOD FIGHTIN was close up from the start, raced wide throughout then made a mild bid late. SARAVA RULES was void of early speed, raced two wide through the turn, then found his best stride late. CAFE KOMODO vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the turn, then gave way late. WITT'S ROAD was slow early, raced along the inside on the turn and was not a factor. GOTASTORM vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faltered late. CALL MY JOB showed good early speed, raced along the inside on the turn, then flattened out in the lane.
