THIS BULLS BACK was unhurried early, raced two wide on the far turn then circled the field at the 1/4 pole and drew off late while under urging. NOTE THE SMOKE pressed the pace early, raced four wide on the last turn, reached contention late then was outfinished. FRANK THE TANK pressed the early pace, contended through the second turn from the three path then faded in the stretch. ROYAL VISION was slow early, raced two wide on the last turn, then found his best stride late. SMOKIN THINGS set the pace early, was headed on the backstretch then entered into a long drive before weakening in the lane. MONEY ISSUES was close up early, raced inside on the second turn, then lacked a late response. KING SNAKE stalked the pace from the start, raced to contention early, was two wide through the far turn then faded in the lane. BEENIE was through early and outrun.
