WESTERN FAULT vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide through the turn, then drew clear late and finished under urging. SISTER BRIDGET pressed the pace early, raced along the inside and contended on the turn, then gave way but held place. TRACY'S STAR vied for the early lead, raced three wide through the turn, then faded in the stretch. GOODFORYOURHEART was slow early, saved ground through the turn, then found her best stride late. TSU TSU FERRY was unhurried early, saved ground on the turn and was not a factor. CARNIVALINHA stalked the pace from the four path through the turn, then flattened out in the lane. CLUELESS CLUE E was close up early, raced along the three path on the turn, then was through after a half.
