### Footnotes

MUSIC CLUB BELLE showed speed from the outset, moved to the front midway on the backstretch, stayed inside around the turn, bore out some under left hand whip and brushed SACRED HONOR in midstretch, then brushed with that one twice again and prevailed. SACRED HONOR was slow early, rallied the five path around the turn, vied outside the winner into the final furlong, was brushed by that one in midstretch then came in under right hand whip and brushed twice more with that one before coming up short. An objection by Otero against the winner was not allowed. MEADOWBOUND stayed out from the rail while not far back but lacked a rally. DOROTHY'S AURORA made the early pace outside the winner, raced two wide between rivals around the turn and weakened. KISS FOR DODIE raced three wide between rivals around the turn and lacked a rally. BREATH TAKING BREEZE was boxed in between rivals nearing the end of the backstretch while behind the leaders, dropped to the inside on the turn and tired.
