THIS BULLS BACK was slow to settle, rallied far out into the track around the turn and finished fastest. BONHEUR was never far back while three wide but lacked a strong closing. FRONT MAN stayed inside and lacked a rally. DR. BALIN broke slowly then was outrun inside. NOT MY PROBLEM was close up to the turn then tired. WHEATON DANCES ON raced wide around the turn and failed to menace. BELLE'S NOTION was sent up the inside early, took over before a quarter then stopped. EX TEMP was finished early.
