COMPLIMENT TREE vied for the early lead from the inside, then drew clear on the far turn, was headed in mid stretch and just lasted at the wire. L'ANCH was unhurried early, raced two wide on the second turn then angled to the outside and reached contention late then missed at the wire. SANDRA LA BELLE pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the last turn but was no match for the leaders. SWEET MINDI lacked speed, saved ground on the last turn and failed to menace. ORIENT SKY was close up early, saved ground on the last turn then faltered in the lane. MALIBU CITI vied for the lead from the two path through then second turn, then flattened out in the stretch. WILD ABOUT AFRICA vied for the early lead from the inside, then the rider's saddle slipped and was outdistanced.
